Loop Road NABA Butterfly Count

Saturday, September 26, 9 am - 4 pm

Join us for our 13th annual Pinecrest (Tri-County) count. Originally scheduled for July 25, we were rained out. Now is your second chance for this ride-and-butterfly field trip.

We meet at the artesian well at the east entrance to Loop Road where it meets the Tamiami Trail at 9 AM. It is on the left, just past Shark Valley and the Miccosukee Village and just before 40-Mile Bend.

We caravan west on the scenic Loop Road for several hours, then return to the Trail, and drive west to the Oasis Visitors Center. After a quick survey of their site we will, on
