Dear Superintendent Ramos:

Thank you for your letter of 1-27-21. We are encouraged by your reply and welcome an opportunity to meet with you and your work group in this regard.

In the meantime, attached are several articles/papers which address the issue of wildlife roadkill including, (i) a Master's thesis of an FIU student regarding the carnage (involving snakes) along the Main Park Road within the so-called Pa-hay-okee wetlands, and (ii) the results of a study of roadkill in national parks generally, in which ENP was a participant. Also attached are several other data sources which generally address the topic. And know that additional data will be provided under separate cover.

Finally, while we welcome the spirit and substance of your letter, we would reiterate our long-standing request that speed limits along the entire Main Park Road be immediately reduced, and that those limits be strictly enforced.
